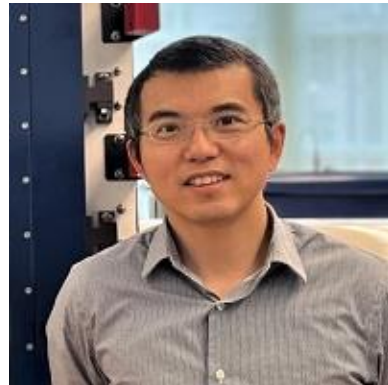

- **Approach: Rebrand and revitalize through an updated charter, new executive committee, and new informational programs**

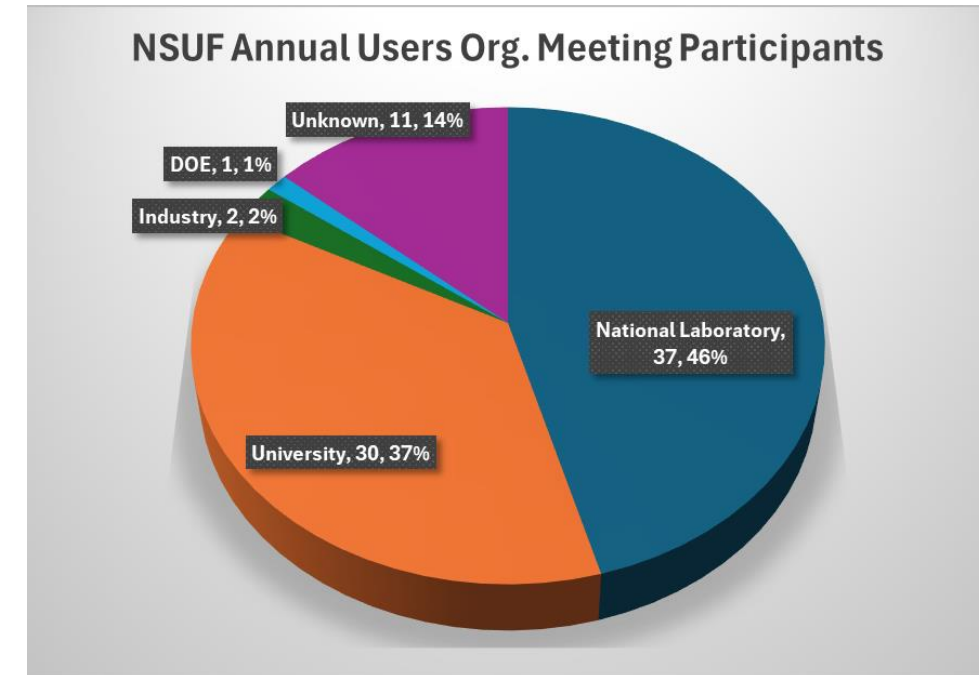
Our Purpose

The purpose of the UO is to promote the advancement of nuclear energy science and technology to meet needs as defined by the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Nuclear Energy and executed through the Nuclear Science User Facilities program through:

1. Providing a formal and clear channel for the exchange of information, advice and best practices between the investigators who perform nuclear technology-driven experiments and the NSUF Management.
2. Serve as an advocacy group for the activities at the NSUF.
3. Educating and informing all stakeholders regarding experimental activities at the NSUF.
4. Facilitating communications among users of the NSUF.

- **Modalities: In person (62) / Virtual (20)**

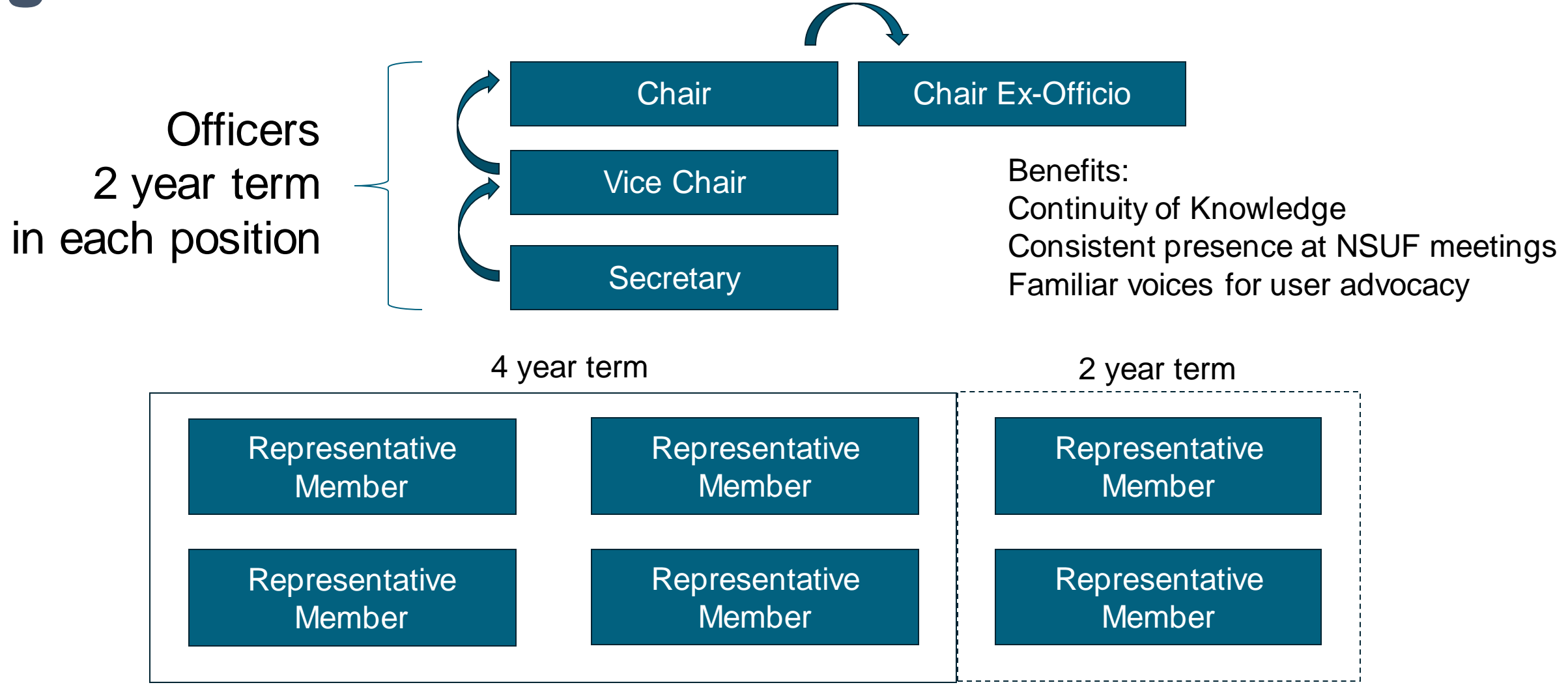


Updated Charter and By Laws – Approved on March 3, 2024

Organizational Structure for Executive Committee



Restrictions imposed:
Exec committee strives to have scientific and institutional diversity reflected and avoid multiple members representing similar interests.
Neither the Chair, Vice-Chair nor Secretary shall be an employee of the organization contracted for the management or operation of Idaho National Laboratory.

Up to 2 positions reserved for emerging professionals (graduate students, postdocs)



Elections

- **Held at Annual NSUF Users Meeting**
- **New positions start Oct 1 with the beginning of the US Government Fiscal Year**
 - Previously started at the beginning of the calendar year
 - Moved to have consistent presence at NSUF program review meetings (spring and fall), and enough time for new Exec Committee to plan NSUF UO Annual Meeting (typically spring)
- **Secretary responsible for election oversight**
