



- Ability to pass a background check



# 625 college interns from 162 institutions




### **INL Postdoc Population Trends**


**Postdocs** make up about 12% of INL researchers, listed as authors on 19% of FY24 INL PEMP publications

# **Creating a Supportive Environment for Postdocs**






### Joint Appointments - Collaborations

### **Joint Appointments -** *Overview*



**Goal** - To enhance research collaborations between INL and university staff.

#### **Changes to program**

- Every appointee receives S#, standard trainings
- Centralized location with program information
- All requests and documents collected and sent electronically
- Self-reporting option for notable achievements
- Directorate review of SOW/JOC during preparation
- Appointment length of 3 years, with review at mid-way point

## **Collaborative Programs**



### **Military**

- As of May 2024, official DOD SkillBridge Program Industry Partner
  - 9 Service Members in FY24 for SkillBridge; 100% conversion rate
- Moving towards Military Academy MOAs to establish regular programming
  - 5 cadets in FY24 summer programming; 3 USAFA, 2 West Point



#### International

- Partner with DOE HQ to facilitate DOS Exchange Visitor Program
  - 14 visitors in FY24, 2 in FY25 to date
  - Visitors are immersed into US culture via lab and community activities
